

House Rules

Warkworth Repair Café

1. Welcome to the Warkworth Repair Café, the work of our volunteers is free of charge, but donations are most welcome to cover costs.
2. All repairs are carried out at your own risk, Warkworth Repair Café are not liable for any loss or injury which may occur as a result of repairs being carried out, or future repairs based on advice given by our repairers.
3. If you have any children with you today, we ask that you ensure they are supervised at all times.
4. We ask that you only bring one item at a time for repair, further items may be accepted for repair if we have time.
5. We encourage you to stay with the volunteer repairer whilst they are carrying out the repair, as this is an opportunity to learn new skills. Items should not be left with the repairer unless agreed with both the visitor and repairer.
6. We ask that you provide any significant / special materials that may be required to carry out the repair. Volunteers may carry a small number of consumable items for use in the repairs.
7. Our volunteers are not obliged to carry out repairs and Warkworth Repair Café are not to be held accountable if your repaired items fail to work at home or breaks again in the future.
8. You are responsible for the removal of your item if it is not possible to repair it.
9. Warkworth Repair Café are not responsible for damage which may be caused to your items whilst in attendance at the café.
10. Warkworth Repair Café will follow all necessary Health and Safety procedures.
